
**A RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE COLUMBUS SECTION OF THE FY 2008-
2011 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (TIP)**

WHEREAS the Governors of Georgia and Alabama have designated the Columbus Department of Planning as the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the Columbus-Phenix City (C-PCTS) urban area; and


WHEREAS it is necessary to amend the Columbus section of the FY 2008-2011 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to include the following project.

P.I. Number 0009401 – 14th Street Pedestrian Bridge / Riverwalk. Rehabilitate existing bridge to a pedestrian bridge. The amount of Federal Funding is \$3,350,000.00 (100% with no match).
