IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (TIP)

Whereas, the Rome - Floyd County Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) adopted the 2008-2011 Transportation Improvement Program; and

Whereas, changes in project funding, scheduling and prioritization by the Georgia Department of Transportation required amendment of the 2008-2011 Transportation Improvement Program; and

Whereas, a public comment period seeking public input to the amendments was held according to the Participation Plan adopted by the Rome-Floyd County Metropolitan Planning Organization; and

Whereas, the 2008-2011 TIP (as amended in 2009) was adopted by the Rome-Floyd County Metropolitan Planning Organization; and

Whereas, an administrative modification of a single project sheet (PI #0001575) is necessary in order to change one federal funding category to another;

THEREFORE, this Transportation Policy Committee now gives its approval to the amended version of the existing 2008-2011 Transportation Improvement Program (as amended in 2009), and approves submittal of the revised plan to the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and the Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT).

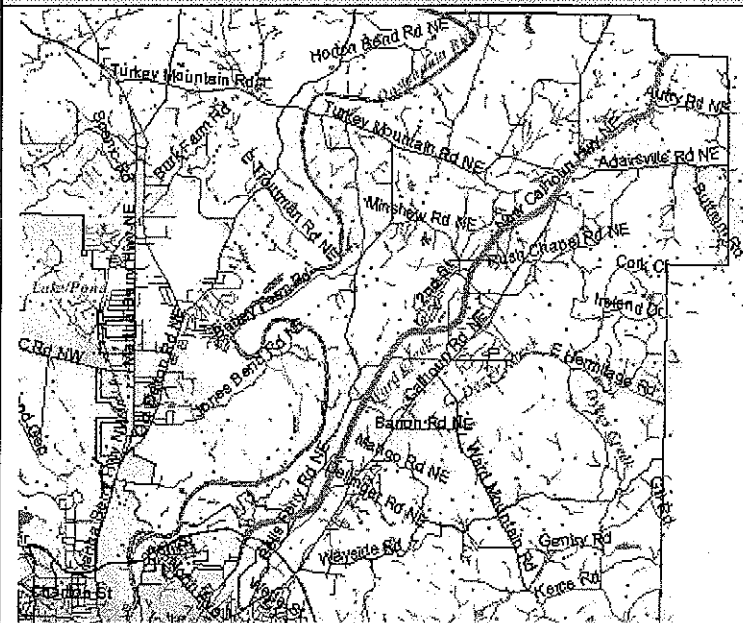
