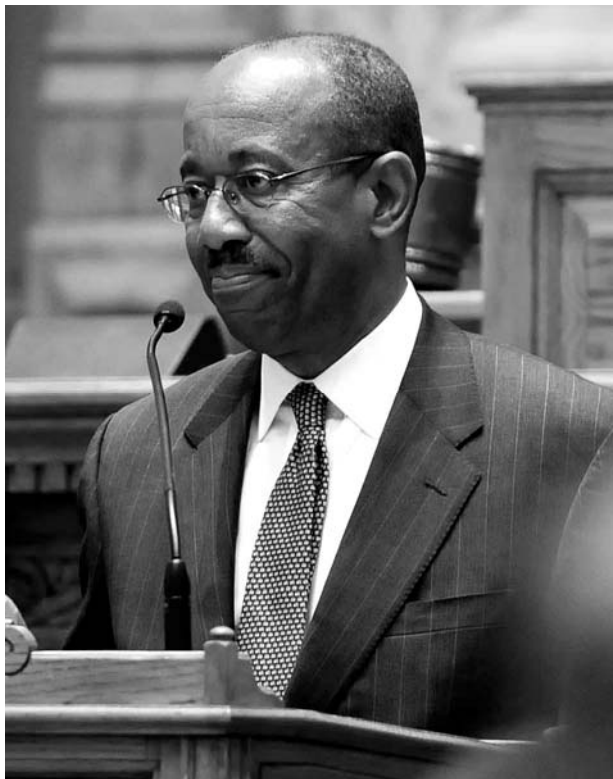
## **ROBERT BROWN RE-ELECTED TO TRANSPORTATION BOARD** *Decatur Architect will continue to represent 4<sup>th</sup> Congressional District*

ATLANTA – Robert L. Brown will continue his service as a State Transportation Board member representing the 4<sup>th</sup> Congressional District for another five-year term. Originally elected to the Board in 2005 to fill the unexpired term of Brad Hubbert, Brown was re-elected to serve his first full term in 2006.

“I am deeply honored to serve five more years as your Transportation Board member dealing with transportation needs in the 4<sup>th</sup> District as well as the state,” said Brown to the members of his delegation. “Georgia DOT is on the right track and has developed a strategic plan that will guide the state for years to come.”
