## **WEATHER DELAYS I-16 RAMP CLOSURE FOR SLAB REMOVAL AND REPLACEMENT**

**WHEN:** **NEW DATES:** Tuesday, January 24 through Thursday, January 26, weather permitting

**WHERE:** I-16 eastbound at Exit 24 entrance ramp

**WHAT:** The Georgia DOT has been notified by the contractor of the scheduled ramp closure for slab removal and replacement of the entrance ramp at Exit 24 to I-16 eastbound.

**Ramp Closures are as follows:**

- Tuesday, January 24: I-16 eastbound entrance ramp from Exit 24, beginning at 7 a.m. until 5 p.m.
- Wednesday, January 25: I-16 eastbound entrance-ramp from Exit 24, beginning at midnight continuously until midnight, Thursday, January 26

The contractor is performing concrete pavement rehabilitation on I-16 on all lanes in each direction beginning at SR 96 (Exit 24) in Twiggs County, continuing through Bleckley County to a point east of SR 278 in Laurens County.

Georgia DOT urges travelers to call 511 for updated information about this or any other construction project on interstates and state routes. Georgia 511 is a free phone service that provides real-time traffic and travel information statewide, such as traffic conditions, incidents, lane closures, and delays due to inclement weather.
