## **NIGHTLY SINGLE LANE CLOSURE ON I-75 SOUTHBOUND FOR BARRIER WALL PLACEMENT**

**WHEN:** 7 p.m. until 7 a.m. nightly, beginning Tuesday, January 24 through Saturday, January 28, weather permitting

**WHERE:** I-75 southbound between mile markers 109 (Exit 109; SR 215/Union Street) and 105 (near Exit 104; Farmers Market Road in Crisp County).

**WHAT:** The Georgia DOT has been notified by its contractor of a nightly single lane closure between mileposts 109 and 105 in Dooly and Crisp Counties on I-75 southbound.

The project consists of 11.55 miles of pavement replacement on I-75 beginning at the Crisp County line and extending to Pinehurst-Hawkinsville Road in Dooly County.

Georgia DOT urges travelers to call 511 for updated information about this project. Georgia 511 is a free phone service that provides real-time traffic and travel information statewide, such as traffic conditions, incidents, lane closures, construction, and delays due to bad weather.
