GEORGIA DOT ANNOUNCES NEW ALL-WAY STOP CONDITION AT THE INTERSECTION OF STATE ROUTE 23/U.S. 301 AND STATE ROUTE 32

Brantley County – The Georgia Department of Transportation announced the intersection of S.R. 23/U.S. 301 and S.R. 32 in the community of Hortense in Brantley County will be converted from a two way stop condition to an **All-Way** stop condition. These changes will take place Tuesday, January 31.

“Please slow down through this area and use extra caution” Georgia DOT Area Engineer Greg Walker said. “Remember to watch out for other drivers as they familiarize themselves with the changes at this intersection, too.”

Upgrades to this intersection will include:

- Changing the existing S.R.23/U.S. 301 overhead yellow flashers to all red flashers.
- The installation of double indicated “Stop Ahead” signs and “Stop” signs on the approaches of S.R. 23/U.S. 301 and S.R. 32.
- The installation of “All-Way Stop” plaques on all approaches.
- Rumble strips will be added to the approaches of S.R. 23/U.S. 301.

Electronic message boards will be temporarily placed on S.R. 23/U.S. 301 and S.R. 32 to inform motorists of the new upcoming stop condition changes.

The Georgia Department of Transportation has notified the Brantley County Sheriff’s Department of these changes and they will be monitoring this area.
