GEORGIA DOT CREWS SCHEDULE DEBRIS AND LITTER PICKUP DETAIL ON SR 85 IN HARRIS COUNTY

WHEN: Daily, 8:30 a.m. until 3 p.m., Wednesday, January 18 through Friday, January 20, weather permitting

WHERE: SR 85 in Harris County from the county line northbound to SR 85 Alternate.

WHAT: Georgia DOT Maintenance crews have scheduled to pick up debris and litter from the shoulders of SR 85. Work is tentatively scheduled between 8:30 a.m. and 3 p.m., daily, Wednesday, January 18 through Friday, January 20, weather permitting.
