CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULED FOR I-20, I-85 AND I-285 THIS WEEKEND

ATLANTA –Crews will be working on three interstates around metro Atlanta this weekend, weather permitting, according to the Georgia Department of Transportation.

On I-20, single lane closures will be in place in both directions between Turner Hill Road and Evans Mill Road to repair drainage structures. Also on I-20 westbound from Panola Road to Wesley Chapel Road, a right lane will be closed for guardrail repairs.

On I-285 westbound, a single right lane closure will be in place from Ashford Dunwoody Road to Roswell Road as crews work on the diverging diamond interchange at Ashford Dunwoody and the bridge widening project at Roswell Road.

Additionally, a double right lane closure is planned all weekend on I-85 southbound near Metropolitan Parkway for bridge deck replacement work

Here is a full list of this weekend's work in metro Atlanta:

Fulton, 1/27/12 to 1/29/12, 9pm till 9:30pm,
I-285 WB, from MP 26.2 (Ga 400) to MP 25 (Roswell Rd), single outside lane for bridge bent construction.

Fulton, 1/27/12 to 1/30/12, 9pm till 5am, continuous
I-85 SB, from MP 78 to MP 77 Metropolitan Parkway, double outside lane closed for bridge deck replacement.

Dekalb, 1/28/12, 7:30pm till 8pm,
I-20 EB, from MP 73.8 (Evans Mill Rd) to 74.7 (Turner Hill Rd), single inside lane to correct drainage issue on inside shoulder.

Dekalb, 1/28/12, 8:30am till 6pm,
I-20 WB, from MP 70 (Panola Rd) to MP 68.5 (Wesley Chapel Rd), single outside lane closed for replacing guardrail.

Dekalb, 1/28/12, 9am till 9:30am

I-20 WB, from MP 75 (Turner Hill Rd) to MP 73.9 (Evans Mill Rd), single inside lane closed to correct drainage issues on inside shoulder.

Dekalb, 1/28/12, 10am till 10:30am

I-20 EB, at MP 67 (I-285 ramp to I-20 EB), inside lane on ramp closed for replacing guardrail.

Dekalb, 1/28/12, 9am till 12pm (Noon)

I-285 WB, from MP 29.5 to MP 29 (Ashford Dunwoody Rd), single inside lane closed for obtaining bolt information for the attachment of strain pole to Ashford Dunwoody Bridge.
